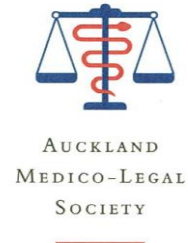

"Medicine and Murder – the central and key role of medical evidence in murder trials"

This letter is to advise you of the details for our End of Year Dinner.

We are delighted to announce the speaker for our dinner will be **Aaron Perkins QC**. Aaron Perkins is one of New Zealand's most experienced criminal prosecutors. For over 25 years he was responsible for managing all trials in the High Court at Auckland under the Auckland Crown Solicitor's warrant, before re-joining the independent bar and taking silk in 2016. Since 1987, Aaron has specialised in the prosecution of homicide trials and has completed more than 100 murder trials and continues to prosecute trials on behalf of the Crown as well as regulatory bodies and government entities. He has represented the Crown in the Waitangi Tribunal, as well as appearing for defendants in both civil and criminal proceedings. For our end of year dinner the Committee is delighted to have Aaron share with us his extensive experience prosecuting homicide cases – in particular, Aaron will shed light on the central role medical evidence takes in almost all murder cases, the variety of medical experts that regularly are essential to the Crown's case in prosecuting murder charges, and the surprisingly crucial importance this evidence plays.
