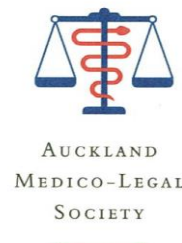

The topic of her speech will be:

Cardiac transplantation after DCD (donation after cardiac death); ethical controversy

Dr Jaime O'Loughlin is the current lead for the Heart and Lung Transplant Programme for New Zealand. She is a consultant Cardiothoracic Anaesthetist at Te Toku Tumai, Auckland Hospital. During 2023 she spent a four-month sabbatical in some of the world's largest and most prominent transplant centres. One of the focus points of this sabbatical was cardiac transplantation when donors undergo cardiac death. This is both a medically and ethically complex area of organ transplantation internationally.
